1. Look and describe.
Example: My father is sitting on the left, while my mother is sitting on the right.



- Say:**
1. What/Who you can see in the picture and where (in the foreground, background, top, bottom...)
 2. What they are doing
 3. What they look like
 4. What they are wearing (they are wearing warm clothes, as it is winter...)
 5. Where and when it is and why you think so (it is indoors/outdoors in winter or summer...)
 6. What their feelings are and why you think so (the boy looks happy, because he is smiling...)
 7. Giving personal opinions: I think/suppose, they had better...; Most people...; I can't see very well, but it probably means that..., dominant colours of the picture/dominant atmosphere of the picture...
 8. Suggestions: please, use the present continuous to describe a picture and a lot of adverbs (frequency adverbs, but even probably, rather, quite, definitively, absolutely, remarkably...) in order to give quality to your description.
